Give thanks for the trip Su Davies has made to Romania, supporting Pastor Otto and Hope Without Limits, with seven UK members on the team, mostly not-believers-yet. They were able to present papers and workshops at the local University in collaboration with the University of Plymouth, assess several very disabled children, review Hope Without Limits finances and set management goals. A key connection was with the President of the occupational therapy association who spent the whole week with us. She is trying to develop the profession in Romania. We need to pray for her and the UK team to be impacted by what they saw and heard of Jesus, and for Otto with his growing ministry — for clear direction, adequate support, good team relationships, protection as always and an infilling of the Holy Spirit as he continually gives out.
