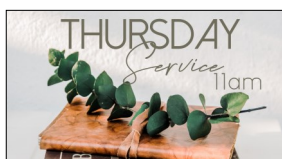

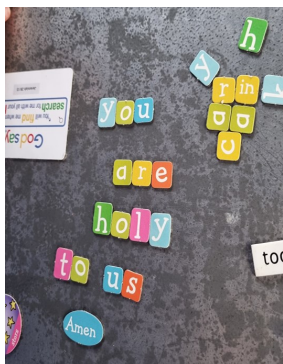

Come and enjoy an alternative to Halloween with fairground games, challenges, food and drinks!



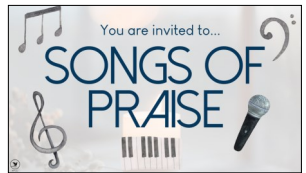

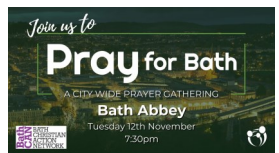
Friday 6 December
