Luke 3:13-21, 31-35

Question 1: What stood out to you in the sermon? Maybe read the passage again as a group and reflect afresh on what stands out to you. In the text.

Question 2A: In the sermon we looked at the diversity of the 12 Disciples and how by societies standards they did not belong together. What does this tell us about Jesus's intention for the Church today in terms of mixed demographics and different backgrounds etc...?

2B: How do we continue to encourage, and develop a culture that embraces people's mess?

2C: How does this idea make us feel?

Question 3: My second point of application was around 'Radical Community.' Despite rarely facing abandonment from our families on account of professing Christ in this country; How might the radical call to follow Christ and enter church community look for us?

Question 4: To close my sermon on Sunday i shared a testimony to explain why the Term 'Church Family' is so important to me. What significance does "Church Family" hold for you? Maybe break off into smaller groups for a time to discuss, then come back together and discuss.
