

## Small Group Questions Sunday 2 March 2025 The God who is still drawing people to himself. Acts 9:1-21

- 1. What were some of the things that stood out to you from Paul's talk on Sunday? Why do you think God drew your particularly attention to those things?
- 2. How did God draw you to himself? (In addition, could ask if anyone has heard a story recently of someone they know who has started following Jesus recently).
- 3. How does the idea the Father is always at work and we just need to get better at figuring out what the Father is doing, encourage you, challenge you? Why?
- 4. What fears stop you sharing about Jesus? Take some time to ask God what he says about that? (Could be a good time to pause and pray for each other).
- 5. Paul quoted this line from a film "You know, sometimes all you need is 20 seconds of insane courage. Just, literally, 20 seconds of just embarrassing bravery. And I promise you, something great will come of it' Matt Daemon character. You bought a zoo. What are your reflections on that quote? What have been your experiences as you have had opportunities of share Jesus?
- 6. 'They took note that they had been with Jesus' Acts 4:13. What does being with Jesus look like for you? How could you re-arrange your everyday life so you could be more with Jesus? (or do life with Jesus, people can automatically think that the only way to be more with Jesus is to have a longer 'quiet time' rather than just making everyday life with Jesus. Practising the presence everywhere)
