



Sermon series: Who Am I?
Small Group Questions: 26 January 2025
Week 4 - 'Salt and Light'.

As we conclude our identity series, we explored the title given to followers of Christ – 'Salt and Light.' In my sermon I described 'Salt and Light' in the following way:

Salt = The preserving Presence that a believer brings into situations and different environments.

Light = The light of Christ, given to each Christian to show people the way to Jesus and to reflect Christ in a dark world.

Question 1: I bookended the sermon with a question – What are we advertising, suggesting that we are walking, talking billboards for the kingdom. Think about and discuss the following:

- What might the first thing be that people are pointed towards when they meet me?
- How can I use my interactions to Point out Jesus?
- What can we do to make sure we are advertising Christ?

Question 2: take some time to discuss how we might be preservative in a world that is broken.

- What could this look like?

Question 3: I suggested that the first three weeks of the 'Who am I' series pointed to us as citizens of the kingdom. Salt and light are a title given to us as kingdom citizens living on earth.

Take some time to consider the following: (as a church or on a personal level)

- Where are we doing this well?
- Where do we need to be more active?
- How can we be billboards for the kingdom this week?
