

WHY GIVE

What is the Significance of a Church Spire?

Spires are designed to direct attention and thought heavenward, symbolizing the Church's connection to the Divine. It is a stone structure to help us follow Paul's imperative

"Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things."

Colossians 3:2

The responsibilities of an historic building

Legally our PCC bears significant responsibilities to preserve the church building. They must ensure that the structure remains safe and stable. This includes regular inspections and repairs to areas that may deteriorate over time. In making repairs we are constrained to using materials and techniques that align with the building's historical period.

Close Up

From ground level our spire looks great, but up close our last inspection revealed a lot of deterioration. Immediate action had to be taken to cordon off the main doors to prevent danger from falling masonry.



HOW MUCH IS NEEDED?

We need to raise

£60.000

to meet the costs of repairing the spire. We are trusting that this will fully fund all the stonework repairs.

If we are blessed with more funds than required we will be able to fund the replacement of our lighting with LED units. This will improve our energy footprint helping to meet current environmental standards.
