What are some ways to structure a sermon? How can we preach with clear purpose and focus?

My sermon writing process: study and pray over the text, commentaries, purpose, structure, content, writing and re-writing, illustrating, and personal application.

Four different types of commentaries: cultural, expository, language, and devotional.

Purpose - Purpose makes preparation exciting.

How do you know your purpose?

Comes from the passage you're preaching.

Comes from prayer.

Comes from a pastoral heart for the people that will hear.

Why is Structure Important?

Good structure helps people listen.

Ken Davis - 'How to Speak to Youth and Keep Them Awake at the Same Time' Good structure can unlock your sermon preparation.

Good structure helps you know what to leave out.

Some basics on structure

What is the purpose of structure?

1. Master a basic structure (it is familiar for people)

Basic structure: intro (get interest), intro (say what will do), body of one point or three points, conclusion. For each point it goes bible, comment, apply.

Body 1 – Take people into the passage and then develop points out of that.

Body 2 – Take people into part of passage with each point.

Point first, middle, or last – can build to point, or state it early.

2. Advanced structure to suit your content.

3. Have a progression in your structure. Build to a climax that leads to response.
